In order to keep our students and staff healthy, we have to adapt our health policies.

If a student has a temperature of 100.4 or higher or ONE high risk symptom or TWO low risk symptoms, the student will need to be picked up as soon as possible. Please have arrangements made if you are unable to pick up your child in a timely manner. Students will be asked to wear a mask until a parent picks them up.

High Risk Symptoms: new cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, new loss of taste or smell.

Low Risk Symptoms: fever, headache, muscle and body aches, fatigue, sore throat, runny nose, congestion, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea.

These students will also be required to be seen by their doctor to return to school. If you need help in this process please contact the school office. The provider may order a COVID test.

If the student tests **negative/has alternative diagnosis**, they may return to school when fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication.

If the student tests **positive** for COVID, they may return to school when:

1. They are fever free for 24 hours without fever reducing medication **AND**
2. Other symptoms have improved **AND**
3. At least 10 days have passed since symptoms first appeared

If parents/families choose not to test their child for COVID or be seen by a physician, the student WILL remain out of school for 10 days. If that happens, the child's teacher will contact the families to coordinate their educational program over those 10 days.

School will no longer have ibuprofen/acetaminophen available for students with headaches. Headaches are a symptom of COVID, and we do not want to cover up symptoms.
