### **Masking**

Based on legislation passed by the Iowa Legislature and signed by Governor Reynolds (HF 847), the board of directors of a school district, the superintendent or chief administering officer of a school or school district, and the authorities in charge of each accredited nonpublic school shall not adopt, enforce, or implement a policy that requires its employees, students, or members of the public to wear a facial covering for any purpose while on the school district's or accredited nonpublic school's property unless the facial covering is necessary for a specific extracurricular or instructional purpose.

Any Student or Staff member may independently decide to wear a mask for their own protection and piece of mind.

### **Cleaning**

Staff will continue to clean high contact areas throughout the day and at a minimum once in the morning and once in the afternoon, during non-instructional times. Cleaning materials will be available for use by individuals if desired. We will also encourage washing hands on a regular basis and hand sanitizer will be available in all classrooms and buses.

### **Transportation**

Any Student or Staff member may independently decide to wear a mask for their own protection and peace of mind. We strongly encourage our students to wear masks while on school sponsored transportation. Buses will be sanitized after each route.

### **Contact Tracing**

At this point, there will be no contact tracing done upon a positive test. Notification of a positive case in a building will be provided via JMC notification and our Facebook page.

### **Isolation:**

COVID-19 positive persons can return to school after 10 days since symptoms first appeared and fever free for 24 hours.

### **Quarantine:**

There currently are no quarantine orders issued by the Iowa Department of Public Health. Parents may choose to have their child(ren) quarantine if they come in contact with a COVID positive individual. If you have another child living in the house with somebody who has COVID this child will need to stay home to quarantine (even if not showing symptoms) for 10 days. This can be shortened to 7 days if this child obtains a negative test on day 5,6 or 7 after your last exposure. If the child is vaccinated, they DO NOT need to quarantine (KCPH information – 8/19/2021).

**Remote learning options:**

This option will not be available.

**Visitors in the School**

Visitors for academic purposes will be allowed subject to building administration approval. We strongly encourage our visitors to mask up when they enter our building.
