

Lu Verne Reopening Protocol Table

As of August 12, 2020

The Lu Verne CSD will consult with Kossuth County Public Health Department (KCPH), Iowa Department of Public Health (IDPH) and Iowa Department of Education on its plan. All plans on this document are subject to change. Keep in mind if the situation warrants we may have to tighten down our restrictions (a couple of examples are: we pre-screen students at the door, we close our building to all guests, students eat in their classroom, etc).

Protocol	
Pre Screening for Students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Parents will screen their children at home for fever (below 100.4 is acceptable) or chills, cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing, fatigue, muscle or body aches, headache, new loss of taste or smell, sore throat, congestion or runny nose, nausea or vomiting, diarrhea. ● Call a medical professional if symptomatic. ● Students do not report to school if symptomatic.
Pick-up / Drop-Off of Students	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● No congregating at the entrance or exit area while waiting for students ● Parents are encouraged to stay in their vehicle during pick-up and drop-off (staff will help).
Entering Building	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Social distancing practices will be in place for entering and exiting the building ● Bus students enter through the south door, all other students use the main entrance. ● Students sanitize hands upon entering the building. ● Temperature may be taken as reasonable and directed by KCPH
Masks/Shields	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students and staff will be required to wear face coverings when social distancing is NOT possible. ● Face shields and masks are available for students and staff to wear as needed.
Hand Washing Hand Sanitizing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students and staff wash or sanitize their hands upon entering the building (i.e. first classroom a student enters), entering and exiting individual classrooms, entering and exiting cafeteria, entering and exiting the office and exiting the building
Touch Surface Cleaning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Enhanced cleaning protocols in place throughout the day
Cafeteria / Meals	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Elem: Breakfast/Lunch in lunchroom following social distancing rules ● Students will be assigned seats and expected to go immediately to that seat. ● Meal trays may be delivered to the students ● Condiments will be in sealed packages
Response to Students who become COVID	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Lu Verne CSD will consult with KCPH and follow their guidance. ● If a student or staff member becomes sick with COVID-19 symptoms during the school day, the

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symptomatic during the day	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> student/staff member will be sent home and encouraged to contact their medical provider. Classroom will be thoroughly cleaned.
Positive Cases and Response	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Lu Verne CSD will consult and follow guidance from KCPH/IDPH Officials We will communicate that “we have a confirmed case in the Elementary involving a student or staff member.” We will NOT identify a specific grade level. KCPH/IDPH will do the contact tracing and notification
Music/PE	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> PE will be outside when possible Locker room is closed Music will follow social distance guidelines and masks may be required
Exploratory Classes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Will initially be in the specials classroom Desks, tables, chairs and common hand touching surfaces will be wiped down between classes
Recess	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Designated areas on the playground and students must stay in that section during that recess time. Designated areas are- playground equipment, basketball court, kickball field No inside recess - if weather is bad, students will stay in their classroom during that time. Line up after recess practicing social distancing with your classroom Staggered entry into the building
Water Fountains	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No mouth drinking from fountains (these have been disabled) Water bottles only (filling stations have been installed)
Field Trips	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Limited field trips Limited assemblies
Passing Periods	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students will walk on the right side of the hallway
Social Distancing	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Social distancing of 3-6 feet will be expected in classrooms when physically possible
Exiting the Building	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Elem: Town walkers and parent pickup dismissed first; Students riding on buses dismissed; Parents encouraged to stay in vehicle; Exit multiple points (one for the bus - south door, one for town and kids getting ride from parents- main entrance) For all students who need to leave the building (have an appointment, are ill, need to leave early, etc.) parents will call the school office upon arrival to the building and the student will be released.
Visitors to School	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Visitors will not be allowed past the school office. The school office will be open to visitors who are wearing a face covering. If a visitor is unable or chooses to not wear face coverings, he/she should call the school upon arrival and we will come to

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	<p>them.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● If a visitor does not have a mask with them, we will have some at our entrance that they can put on. ● We may close the building to visitors at any time.
Transportation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Students are assigned seats ● Students are strongly encouraged to wear face coverings on the bus. If after consultation with KCPH/IDPH, the district may request that all students wear face coverings on the bus. ● Surfaces are wiped down between routes ● Students will be spaced apart as permitted by the number of riders.
Facility usage by outside organizations	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Use of facilities by outside groups will be very limited. ● Outside groups will be required to follow IDPH guidance ● Outside groups will be required to sign a COVID-19 release document (school board policy) and may be required to pay for additional cleaning of the facility
Extracurricular Activities	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Guidance from Iowa High School Athletic Association, Iowa High School Girls Athletic Union, Iowa Department of Education, and local public health officials will be followed for all extracurricular activities ● Will follow KCPH Officials for out of state travel recommendations

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
